

Getting Started with Classroom Level Reporting

On the Schoolnet home page (My Schoolnet) and the Reporting Dashboard, find student assessment information to identify student needs based on recent assessment data. Shortcuts provide quick access to additional reports.



On the home page, My Schoolnet, use the My Classroom 'widget' to select the class of students you wish to view. Administrators have additional menus to select a teacher and school if applicable.

Reporting Dashboard: Classroom Level

The Reporting Dashboard provides a way to easily see and filter all assessments for a selected class. There is a link in the upper right to change between current and total enrollment. The default is for current enrollment, but you can select 'All Students' if you want to see performance for past students as well. Underneath the enrollment filter is a shortcut for the **Standards Performance** report which can be used to compare multiple assessments.

Test Results Tab

By default, teachers will see their name and a menu to select a class or multiple sections of the same course. There are filters to limit which tests appear on the dashboard. When a class is selected, all links to reports go to classroom level reports.
