## Open Response Items and Rubrics

Open response is a flexible item type that can be used to capture student responses online.

Rubrics provide expectations of quality around a task to define consistent criteria for grading. Some rubrics are available to you in the Item Bank for use with open response items.

## Create an Open Response Item with a Rubric


You can attach any available rubrics to open response items. Items can be created individually or as part of a test.

*To create an open response with a rubric as part of an existing test draft:*

1. In a test draft, click **Add Item** and then select **Open Response**
2. Scroll down to the Scoring sections and click **Select Rubric**
3. Click **+ Attach** next to the desired rubric
4. Enter the Question Content
5. Select a point value, or values, if applicable, to weight a skill
